College of Pharmacy (Degree) at Sector-B, C.B.D., New Bombay

Sir,

I am directed to convey that on the basis of the recommendations made by the Standing Committee of the Western Regional Committee (WRC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval for establishment of Bharati Vidyapeeth's College of Pharmacy (Degree) at Sector-B, C.B.D., New Bombay from the academic session 1993-94 with an annual intake of 60 students subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. The College should strictly observe all rules and regulations stipulated by the AICTE, State Govt., Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and other approval/affiliating bodies.
2. Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE from time to time and as adopted by the State Govt. and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
3. Reservations shall be provided for students and staff as per policy of the State Government applicable from time to time.
4. The tuition fee and other fees should be within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE and as adopted by the State Govt.
5. The teaching staff should be recruited on All India basis by open selection and as per procedure, qualifications experience etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selections would be permissible for such posts for which the State Govt. prescribes "State-based Selection" as a general policy.
6. The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching and other staff.
7. The Management including the Governing Council of the Institute shall be constituted and the Chairman of the Council appointed as per the guidelines of the AICTE.

8. The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
9. A duly registered undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper must be submitted by the end of December, 1993 for fulfilment of the general conditions.
10. The College shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.


This approval is also subject to full compliance with the SCIFHC as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 4.2.1993 on WPC No.607 of 1992 with other WPs in the case of Dhanirishnan, J.P. and others etc. etc. vs State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE or the Central Government from time to time.

The College will be inspected by an Expert Committee of Western Regional Committee (WRC) by March, 1994 for reviewing the progress made in compliance with the above cited conditions.

In the event of non-compliance by the Institute with any of the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to withdrawal of approval would be that of the Institute.


You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the Western Regional Committee (WRC) Bombay and the AICTE Delhi informed of the progress made in this behalf.
